

**IN THE 506TH JUDICIAL DISTRICT COURT
GRIMES COUNTY AND WALLER COUNTY, TEXAS**

This Order is issued pursuant to Emergency Order Authorizing Modification and Suspension of Court Procedures in Proceedings Affected by Disaster, dated August 28, 2017, as issued by The Supreme Court of Texas in Misc. Docket No. 17-9091, and The Court of Criminal Appeals of Texas in Misc. Docket No. 17-010.

All civil and criminal deadlines and procedures prescribed by statute, rule or order, in any case, civil or criminal, are hereby extended for a period of 17 calendar days beginning August 25, 2017, and ending September 11, 2017. All discovery, filings, pleadings, notices, and other matters that are or were required to be filed on August 25, 2017, and on any day thereafter until and including September 10, 2017, shall now be due on September 11, 2017, without penalty or other requirement. Counsel may agree to avoid the effects of this Order by a Rule 11 Agreement, in writing between counsel.

Further extensions of this Order may be considered by the Court on a case-by-case basis until the expiration of the above referenced Orders on September 27, 2017.

The District Clerks of Grimes County and Waller County shall take notice of this Order. However, filings, notices, requests and other proceedings received or required in the due order of business shall be handled without regard to this Order.
